



Biodiversity in Italy

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The marsican brown bear



HABITAT

This animal is a mammal that lives in the central part of Italy. The male of the species has a weight reaching about 230 kg in autumn period while females rarely exceed 140 kg. The Bear has a very developed hearing and a very acute sense of smell that helps him in the search for food, instead the view is rather mediocre.

REPRODUCTION

The reproduction starts in may. This species lives and is protected in the woods of the Abruzzo National Park



Gallina prataiola



HABITAT

This animal frequents flat or hilly grassy plains from sea level to 500 meters of altitude. It feeds on both plants and insects. It is generally active during the twilight hours.

REPRODUCTION

This animal reproduce in Sardinia, nesting take place between March and July.



Spectacled salamander



HABITAT

It is endemic to Italy north of the Volturno River. It mainly frequents mountainous and hilly areas, usually between 200 m and 900 m of altitude.

PARTICULARITIES

It prefers forest areas with abundant undergrowth. It uses trees, streams and water courses as a den. Its bright colors serve to ward off predators who consider it a potentially poisonous species



Glandural broom

PARTICULARITIES

The glandular broom is an endemic species of the metropolitan area of Rome.

PERIOD OF BLOOM

It grows in open shrubby vegetations and in heaths, on usually siliceous substrates, from the hills to the mountains.



Elleboro di boccone

PARTICULARITIES

the elleboro di boccone is a plant present only in Italy from emilia romagna to sicily. it is an herbaceous plant about 20-40 cm tall.

PERIOD OF BLOOM

It blooms from February to April and presents yellow-green droopy petals.



Capellini delle torbiere

HABITAT

This type of plant is present only in Italy, more precisely in Tuscany.

PERIOD OF BLOOM

The dimension of Cappellini delle torbiere is 2-6 dm tall herbaceous plant blooms from June to July. it grows near sulphurous springs.
